### Directions to HCC

#### From Interstate 70

Take exit 32B on to Rt-40 West (Dual Highway). At the first stoplight turn right on to Edgewood Drive. Edgewood will become Robinwood Drive. Turn left at third stoplight on to the HCC Campus.

#### From Interstate 81

Take interstate 70 E (Exit 4) to Frederick and follow the above directions.
