2. Assignment : Policy:
 - a. Develop policy addressing academic eligibility to participate in Intercollegiate Athletics
 - b. Develop policy addressing academic eligibility to hold a student leadership position
 - c. Develop a policy that addresses what types of student activities are endorsed by the College

 - (1) Carry minimum 12 credits in the semester in which they are playing their sport at HCC
 - (2) NJCAA requirements are that students must complete 48 credits in two years, with a grade point average 2.0 or higher
 - (a) There is a slight variation in the way HCC and NJCAA compute GPA

 - b. Nothing in HCC catalog that specifically addresses academic standing for Student Athletes, our College catalog only addresses Academic standing for ALL Students.
