In order to qualify for state testing, students must pass each mod exam in both EMS 120 AND EMS 121 with a 70% or greater. Additionally, Students must pass all skills testing in both courses. Finally, in order to qualify for testing, students must take and pass both EMS 120 and EMS 121 consecutively and in that order.
