Total of 26 students successfully completed the course 8 A's, 29 B's, 3 C's, 0 D's, 0 F (two students withdrew due to personal issues.) Exam average was 85.05% with all students earning a 75% or higher on their exams.

ATI proficiency; Level 3 = 42 (4.9%), Level 2 = 25 (61 %), Level 1= 13 (31.7%) Below level 1 = 1 All Levels demonstrating positive shift.

Follow-up (How have you used or how will you use the data to improve student learning?) In order to facilitate student learning, I have adjusted the course schedule to facilitate focusing on specific disease states and am spending more time on drugs used for neurological or psychological conditions. An extra activity to learn drug names with a focus on cardiovascular and psychological drugs has been added. Enhanced lectures using Camtasia software have been added to assist students with their self-study.
