Learning Outcomes:

1. Incorporate the nursing process to provide care to individuals with complex healthcare needs.
2. Demonstrate safety measures when providing care to all individuals in various settings.
3. Integrate ethical and legal principles into the care of individuals with complex healthcare needs.
4. Demonstrate sensitivity to the individual and family in a stressful situation.
5. Begin to interact with the individual, family, and the healthcare team therapeutically.
6. Work together with the healthcare team in providing care to the individual.
7. Adjust work plan to improve organizational skills and available resources.
8. Explore opportunities to promote personal and career growth.
9. Demonstrate continuity of care for multiple individuals.

Assessment:

- Final Exam
- ATI Content Mastery Assessment Examination for Mental Health
- Clinical Evaluations

Validation:

- Exam average with 75% or higher scores
- ATI Content Mastery Assessment Examination: expectation of Level 2 or 3

Results:

- Exam average: 0 out 15 scored less than 75%
- ATI Content Test Mastery Examination on Mental Health
 - Level 3: 1 student
 - Level 2: 12 students
 - Level 1: 2 students
 - Below Level 1: 0 students
- Clinical: 15 out of 15 successful

Follow-up:

- Final Exam: revise content in next course to follow NCLEX test plan
- ATI: Each student will meet with instructor to develop an individual remediation plan; then each student will retake the assessment test one additional time to monitor improvement
- ATI: Instructors will review and alter course content to improve teaching by focusing on the content students obtained a score less than 50%
