## SGA Election Guidelines—2013-14 Academic Year

## **CAMPAIGNING INFORMATION:**

The campaigning time frame is Monday, April 1, through Friday, April 12. All campaigning of candidates is subject to approval by the Student Activities office/Elections and Nominations Committee. You will need to submit an application, .jpg photo, and short bio of yourself for the on-line voting site. Send your information

to <u>hbbarnhart@hagerstowncc.edu</u>. Applications are available in the Student Activities Office.

The following guidelines must be followed. Candidates are responsible for funding their campaign. Donations/sponsorships will not be allowed. Get creative with your campaigning, but remember to run your ideas past the Student Activities Coordinator for approval.

- 1. Posters may be posted throughout the campus, after approved by the Student Activities Office.
- 2. Flyers may be distributed to persons on campus.
- 3. Colored and white copy paper is available in the Student Activities Office for you to use, along with a black/white printer and copier.
- 4. Student Activities has a button maker you can use free of charge.
- 5. Student Activities will send out <u>ONE</u> mass e-mail to all students regarding your run for office. You must submit the wording if you would like this to be done.
- 6. No disfigurement of campus buildings and properties will be permitted.
- 7. Chalk is ok on the blacktop around the Quad. The HCC grounds crew is not responsible for cleaning up your campaign messages.
- 8. Printed materials may NOT be affixed to any vehicles or building entry doors.
- 9. A candidate and their campaigning team are responsible for making and posting all printed material. This material is to be removed within two days after the election is completed.
- 10. Any disparagement or negativity directed toward another candidate is grounds for dismissal from the election.
- 11. If you or someone on your campaign team are caught removing other candidates' campaign materials, you will be dismissed from the election.

## **VOTING INFORMATION:**

Voting is open to any current full or part time credit student. Voting will be held on-line through the HCC Web site April 15 – 17. For additional information about election days, please see Article V, Section 3 of the SGA Constitution, found on page 36 of the Student Handbook.
