Program Description:

The Transfer Incentive Program (TIP) offers students who have earned an associate's degree up to a **\$2,000 scholarship** for up to five semesters to complete a qualifying bachelor's degree at Morgan State University.

Program Requirements:

- + Earn an associate's degree by August 2014
- + Plan to major in one of the following subjects:

Actuarial Science	Finance
Chemistry	History
Construction Management	Mathematics
Economics	Philosophy
Engineering Physics	Physics
English	Theater

Once Enrolled:

- + Maintain a semester and cumulative 2.5 grade point average
- + Remain enrolled in the selected major of study
- + Successfully complete a minimum of 15 credits per semester
- + Follow the degree plan provided by the department chairperson or academic advisor

To Apply:

- + Complete the online admissions application and pay the \$35 fee
- + Submit an official transcript for each school previously attended
- + Complete the FASFA and use Morgan's code, 002083
