# Ice Breaker: Ball Name Toss

- Have students count off one, two, one, two, and so on.
- Tell all of the ones to form a circle in one area, and all of the twos in another area.
- Hand a ball to a student in both circles.
- Instruct the student to toss the ball to another student in the circle and state that student's name (if they are unsure encourage them to ask). It is important to remember who they threw it to.
- Have students continue this pattern, but provide the instruction, "Do not throw it to someone that has already received it."
- Once every student in both circles has received the ball once, have them repeat the same exact pattern once more (saying the student's name before they throw the ball).
- Have the students compete, Team One versus Team Two. Both teams will start at the same time.
- After students have practiced, have them race while accomplishing the pattern backwards. (Another variation is to add two Koosh balls to each circle).
