### ***College Expenses***

- Is the college public or private?
- How much is tuition for a full-time student per year (24 credits)?
- Is there housing (dorms, suites, apartments) available on campus?
- How much is room and board?
- Estimate the amount needed for books, supplies, transportation, food, etc.
- Application fee? Is a waiver available?
- If accepted, how much is the required deposit?

### ***Housing***

- Residence hall requirements (do you have to live on campus)?
- Types of housing offered

### ***Facilities/Campus Buildings***

- Academic (libraries, computer labs, internet access, learning centers. etc.)
- Recreational (student center, gym, dining halls, field houses, student lounges, etc.)
- Transportation (bus/metro/ student parking)
- Other (health center)
