Review of Program Objectives

- Participants served during the project year will have a <u>2.5</u> <u>cumulative GPA or better</u>
- UB seniors served during the project year will have achieved at the proficient level on state assessments in reading/language arts and math.
- Project participants served during the project year will <u>continue in</u> <u>school for the next academic year</u>, at the next grade level, or will graduate.
- Current and prior UB participants will complete <u>a rigorous</u> <u>secondary school program of study</u>.
- UB graduates will <u>enroll in a program of postsecondary education</u> <u>by the fall term immediately following high school graduation</u> (exception: spring deferment).
- Participants will <u>attain either an associate's or bachelor's degree</u> within six years following graduation from high school.

Summer Academy Wrap-Up

- 50 students participated in the 2014 Summer Academy
- Students could earn up to 2 high school elective credits or 3 college credits; bridge students could earn up to 12 college credits
- Curriculum subjects: English, math, science, world language
- Cost to the student: \$0
- Team Building activities, 5 college visits with cultural enrichment activities, Community Service opportunity
- Over 150 people attended the End-of-the-Year reception


