COURSE: EMS 281 – EMS Practicum III 3 Credits

INSTRUCTOR: SEMESTER/YEAR: Fall 2015

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This course provides opportunities to apply the knowledge and skills of EMS 163 and EMS 164 in supervised clinical settings. Course fee required. Total of 150 hours of clinical and in class seminars.

TEXTBOOK: None

STUDENT LEARNING OUTCOMES:

- Perform a cumulative amount of 30 pediatric assessments, 40 adult assessments, 15 trauma assessments, 10 AMS patients, and 20 Team Leads.
- Demonstrate positive patient and team interaction.
- Document patient interaction, including patient complaint, signs/symptoms, physical exam, history, diagnostic treatment, and treatment.
- Work as part of a team in evaluating and treating patients in the hospital and prehospital environments.
- Assess patients of different ethnicities while considering cultural beliefs.

COURSE WORKLOAD: Each 3 credit course requires a total of 112.5 hours of instructional time/student work. The course will have 37.5 hours of instructional time and 75 hours will account for student work outside of instructional time. The average is 5 hours per week of student work.
