1. 3 unit exams, and a final exam to achieve 75% and success in passing class.

**Validation** (What methods have you used or will you use to validate your assessment?)

1. 100% of students will achieve a 75% or greater on 3 unit exams and 1 final exam.
2. 100% of the students will receive a 90% or greater on the calculation exam within 2 attempts.
3. 90 % students will pass the Mental Health Proctored ATI exam at a Level 2 or above.
4. 90 % of the Weekly clinical assessments will be passing.
5. Final clinical evaluation 100 % of the students will receiving a passing grade .
6. 100 % of the students will achieve a 75% or better on the Research paper.
7. 100 % of the students will achieve a 75% or better on the A. A. Paper.

**Results** (What do your assessment data show? If you have not yet assessed student achievement of your learning outcomes, when is assessment planned?)

- 1 100% of the students received a 75% or greater on the exams.
- 2 100% of students achieved 90% or greater on the calculation exams. Note all first time passes.
- 3 The Mental Health Proctored ATI exam . ATI=Level 3= 2 Level 2=26 Level 1= 5 below level 1=1. . We are not yet to the 90% goal of level 2 or above but are at 85%.
- 4 Greater than 90% of the weekly assessments were passing.
5. 100% of the final clinical evaluations were noted to be passing.
- 6/7 100% of the students received higher than 75% on the Research paper and AA paper .

The ATI proctored exam is counted in a portion of the final grade in this class. This adds additional importance in outcomes for the students.
