Upcoming Activities

Haunted House trip- We are still looking for a date and time. Most likely the trip will be on a Friday in October.

Haunted railroad trip- These only are on Saturday nights from October- November. We're not sure what day or tie yet.

Club Fair- Wednesday, September 23rd 11am- 3pm and 5pm- 7pm. We need club members to sign up to sit at the table to give out popcorn and recruit new club members. This is a *point opportunity!*
