TIPS FOR SUCCESS IN ONLINE CLASSES

Take responsibility for your learning

- Taking an online course requires you to take responsibility for own progress.
- The key is to stay motivated and try your best to adhere to all deadlines.
- If you find yourself falling behind, you can always reach out to the instructor for assistance just like you would in a live classroom setting.

2 Pace yourself

- Allow yourself sufficient time to get the reading and assignments completed each week.
- You will not have a scheduled class time, but you will have many deadlines.
- Avoid waiting until the last minute, just in case you run into any technical issues.
- **3** Always have a back-up plan
 - In case of an emergency or personal issue, your instructor's contact information is always listed in the class syllabus.

- You should contact HCC's Help Desk team for assistance, at the first sign of any technical issues.
- There are computers readily available for students on the HCC campus in the Learning Support Center (LSC).
- 4 Check the online classroom and your HCC email account on a regular basis
 - Throughout the semester, students are encouraged to check their email on a daily basis.
 - Being present in the virtual classroom is essential in the online environment, since your instructor may post last minute reminders, homework tips or updates to the class schedule.
