Related to Infection Control, more examples of the chain of infection, breaking it and the importance of controlling infection in health care settings with be discussed and assignments will be created to enhance understanding of this topic. More microbiology will be incorporated using common pathological conditions the students are familiar with, to include what microorganism is the cause and what can be done to prevent the spread of that condition.

More modern health care advances will be explored, such as legal cases that involved advances, and discussions and worksheets and scenarios will be incorporated.
