Are you eligible for Job Training Student Resources' (JTSR) services?

You may be eligible if:

1. You are a **PELL eligible** student \*  
AND
2. You are **24 years of age or older** \*\*  
AND
3. You are **enrolled and actively registered** for courses toward a career program at HCC.

\*Students must first apply and be eligible for Federal Aid by completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

\*\* Students under 24 years of age may be eligible if the Student Financial Aid office qualifies them as an independent student.

# What steps do I take?

1. **Complete an HCC application** – go to [www.hagerstowncc.edu](http://www.hagerstowncc.edu) and choose “future students.”
2. **Apply for Financial Aid** – Be sure you have completed the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) available at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov). 3. **Choose a program of study and register for classes** – If you have not completed this and need help, please see the Academic Advising and Registration office located in the Student Center.
