COURSE DESCRIPTION: Using PowerPoint, students learn to create and edit electronic slides, organizational charts, templates, and poster presentations. Students learn the qualities of good presentations and techniques for presenting topics to their audiences. Prerequisite: IST 102 or consent of instructor.

TEXTBOOK: Go with Microsoft Office: PowerPoint, Comprehensive. 2013, Gaskin, Ferrett and Martin. Pearson/Prentice Hall.

• Plan, research, develop, and present effective presentations using PowerPoint

Total Hours of Coursework: To earn one academic credit at HCC, students are required to complete a minimum of 37.5 clock hours (45 fifty-minute "academic" hours) of coursework per semester.
