COURSE DESCRIPTION: *This course provides supervised clinical experience in area facilities for the skills learned in EMS 120, EMS 121, and EMS 151. Course fee required. Total of 60 hours clinical and in class seminars.*

STUDENT LEARNING OUTCOMES:

- Demonstrate competent placement of intravenous catheters, intubation tubes, and other devices, as trained in the paramedic program classroom.
- Accurately document patient encounters through the use of physical or electronic documentation systems.
- Utilize appropriate medication therapy in treating patients.
- Explain the role of key hospital personnel and departments in continuing the care begun by paramedics.
- Utilize the appropriate rules of conduct concerning communication and interpersonal relationships.

COURSE WORKLOAD: Each 1 credit course requires a total of 37.5 hours of instructional time/student work. The course will have 12.5 hours of instructional time and 25 hours will account for student work outside of instructional time. The average is 1.6 hours per week of student work.
