A hands-on competency based course. Computer Aided Design (CAD) 228 builds on skills and knowledge gained in previous CAD classes. Students receive instruction in use of parametric, solid modeling software (AUTODESK Inventor TM) to construct, assemble and animate 3 dimensional models.

STUDENT LEARNING OUTCOMES:

Upon completion of this class the student will be able to:

- Create solid models using parametric based software.
- Create assemblies using created parts and the content center.
- Create working drawings, exploded drawings and parts lists of assemblies
- Create animations of solid model assemblies.
- Use the software to analyze material properties and perform finite element analysis.
- Work in teams to design mechanical systems that can be used to fabricate a prototype of their choice.

TOTAL HOURS REQUIRED FOR THIS COURSEWORK:

To earn one academic credit at HCC, students are required to complete a minimum of 37.5 clock hours (45 fifty-minute "academic" hours) of coursework per semester. Those hours of coursework may be completed through a combination of hours within the classroom and hours outside the classroom. Certain courses may require more than the 37.5 minimum hours of coursework per credit.

For most classes, students should expect to do at **LEAST** 2 hours of coursework outside of class for each hour of in-class coursework.
