COURSE: THR 102 – Elements of Dramatic Production (3 credit hours)

INSTRUCTOR:

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Basic elements of production, including acting, directing, set design and construction, lighting, makeup, and costuming are presented. Students will apply the knowledge and sharpen their skills through participation in a College production.

STUDENT LEARNING OUTCOMES:

As a result of hands-on participation in the semester’s production, the student should be able to:

- Describe the working relationships among Director, Producer, Set and Costume Designer, Technical and House management -
- Prepare and Deliver a competent and competitive audition for a role in the Academic Theatre setting –
- Demonstrate how at least one aspect of Set, Lighting, Sound, Property, and/or Costume Design are integrated into a live public performance -
- Evaluate one’s personal growth in the understanding of Theater during the production rehearsal process in the individual’s chosen/assigned role(s) and responsibility(s) by use of a pre and post rehearsal and production self-assessment.

MINIMUM CLOCK HOURS REQUIRED FOR THIS COURSE

To earn one hour of academic credit at HCC, students are required to complete a minimum of 37.5 clock hours (45 fifty-minute “academic” hours) of coursework per semester. Those hours of coursework may be completed through a combination of hours within the classroom and hours outside the classroom. Certain courses may require more than the 37.5 minimum hours of coursework per credit. A three credit hour course requires 112.5 clock hours.

For most classes, students should expect to do at least 2 hours of coursework outside of class for each hour of in-class coursework.
