Overview of Shippensburg University's General Education Program

- ^CCategory C Biological & Physical Sciences (3 courses – 9 credits)
- ^DCategory D Political, Economic, and Geographic Sciences (2 courses – 7 credits)
- ^ECategory E Social and Behavioral Sciences (2 courses – 6 credits)

3. Courses for Shippensburg University have been selected by joint agreement of HCC and SU. However, curricula are subject to change. This guide should be used with the assistance of a HCC Counselor/Advisor. Following the guide does not guarantee transfer of credit or admission into Shippensburg University. Please speak with your advisor and/or the SU transfer advisor if you have any questions. A transfer advisor from Shippensburg University visits HCC on a monthly basis throughout the academic year. 4. The Social Work major allows for 16-17 free elective credits. The minimum GPA required for admission is 2.5 with 60 or more credits completed.
