

Course Outcomes Assessment

Course/Program Title: DHY 102 Pre-Clinic

Date: 12/17/2018

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Expected Learning Outcomes:

- Demonstrate clinical dental hygiene skills and assessment procedures under self assessment and direct observation conditions.
- Develop a dental hygiene plan of action for a student partner, then complete and evaluate the oral prophylaxis process.
- Create clinical patient assessment documents that adhere to legal and ethical standards.

Assessment: Assessments include weekly journaling (10% of overall grade), weekly quizzes (15% of overall grade), formative assessments (15% of overall grade), summative assessments (40% of overall grade), observations (5% of overall grade), Clinic engagement (5% of overall grade), and Assessment Scale final (10% of overall grade). Students are required to achieve an overall grade of 75% or better on all assessments, as well as overall course grade of 75% or better.

Validation: This is a Pre-clinic course, in which the course grade is determined by completion of all course assessments with a goal of 100% of students achieving an average of 75% or higher.

Results: These results are based, on one student who was enrolled in the course during the fall, 2018 semester.

Follow-up: DHY 10 students continually improved instrumentation with formative and summative assessments. The content from Pre-Clinic instruction began to connect with the hands-on skills required for the clinical environment. In other words, concepts on instrumentation began to connect with the students as more instruments were introduced.

Adjustments will continually be made to link the practical/clinical aspects of dental hygiene with direct patient care.
