**Assessment** (How do or will students demonstrate achievement of each outcome?)

1. 3 unit exams, and a final exam to achieve 75% and success in passing class.
2. Calculation exam
3. ATI Mental Health Proctored exam.
4. Weekly clinical assessments
5. Final Evaluation
6. Research Paper
7. AA Paper

**Validation** (What methods have you used or will you use to validate your assessment?)

1. 100% of students will achieve a average of 75% or greater on 3 unit exams and 1 final exam.
2. 100% of the students will receive a 90% or greater on the calculation exam within 2 attempts.
3. 90 % students will pass the Mental Health Proctored ATI exam at a Level 2 or above.
4. 90 % of the Weekly clinical assessments will be passing.
5. Final clinical evaluation 100 % of the students will receive a passing grade .
6. 100 % of the students will achieve a 75% or better on the Research paper.
7. 100 % of the students will achieve a 75% or better on the A. A. Paper.

**Results** (What do your assessment data show? If you have not yet assessed student achievement of your learning outcomes, when is assessment planned?)

- 1 100% of the students received a 75% average or greater on the exams.
- 2 100% of students achieved 90% or greater on the calculation exams. Note all first time passes.
- 3 94% of the students in fall 2018 psych classes (A & B) passed the Ati proctored with a level 2 or above. We had 2 out of 37 students who received a level 1- one of these students missed level 2 by one question the other is a paramedic student to RN who was much lower. Last semester 75.8% received a level 2 or greater on the proctored (this was a smaller class 29 verses 37.
- 4 100 % of the weekly assessments were passing.
5. 100% of the final clinical evaluations were noted to be passing.
6. 100 % of the students received higher than 75% on the Research paper 100% of the students had higher the 75% on the AA paper .

**Follow-up** (How have you used or how will you use the data to improve student learning?)

The ATI proctored exam is weighted as 10% of the final grade in this class. This adds additional importance in outcomes for the students. We will continue this weighting it has shown to be valuable.

We continue with the 2 community members as guest speakers to speak on their life journeys related to drug addiction and recovery and 1 young man dx with schizophrenia who shared his

story and experiences. I believe real life stories and meeting these folks is enriching and provides application devices to the students.
