



# Getting Started at HCC



Thank you for your interest in enrolling at Hagerstown Community College. To be ready to schedule your classes, please make sure the following steps are completed as soon as possible:

1. Submit an Application for Admission (no fee) and send it to the Office of Admissions. You may apply online at [www.hagerstowncc.edu/admissions](http://www.hagerstowncc.edu/admissions).
2. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) - if applicable.
  - If you plan to use financial aid or apply for scholarships to finance your college education, you must complete the FAFSA. Submit the form online at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov). For more information about financial aid, go to [www.hagerstowncc.edu/financial-aid](http://www.hagerstowncc.edu/financial-aid) or call 240-500-2473. Financial Aid TV is also available on the HCC website. High school students in the ESSENCE Program or the Middle College may complete the FAFSA to apply for a PELL Grant or additional scholarships.
3. Submit official transcripts to the Office of Admissions.
  - This may include high school transcripts, college/university transcripts, and GED scores.
4. Review placement testing information online at: [www.hagerstowncc.edu/testing](http://www.hagerstowncc.edu/testing).
  - You may be exempt from taking the placement tests based on SAT, ACT, PARCC, AP, IB, GED, or CLEP scores. To see if you are exempt from testing, visit [www.hagerstowncc.edu/academic-testing-center/placement-testing](http://www.hagerstowncc.edu/academic-testing-center/placement-testing). If you are exempt from placement testing based on one of these test scores, please submit an official copy of the test scores to the Office of Admissions and Enrollment Management.

  - Free web-based tutorials are available on the Testing Center website.
5. Meet with an Academic Advisor and schedule classes.
  - All new students must meet with an Academic Advisor to register for classes. Advisors are available on a walk-in basis in the Student Center.
  - All high school students who are taking courses concurrently with HCC must submit a completed ESSENCE form. Forms can be obtained from the high school guidance office or at [www.hagerstowncc.edu/essence](http://www.hagerstowncc.edu/essence). Students must make an appointment to schedule classes. Please call 240-500-2238 to make an appointment. Registration for classes offered at local high schools will be conducted in the classroom when the class begins.
