59% (13/22) completed the course with a grade of 75% or greater 41% (9/22) completed the course below 75%. 2 D's and 7 F's

Follow up - Section 01 Lecture Based

 $CO\ 1$ – More time will be spent on the initial aspects of building medical terms, how to do it, more practice exercises in defining the word parts and the rules used to build medical terms.

CO 2 – Abbreviations will be discussed and practiced more in class with activities and worksheets.

More time will be spent reviewing for the quizzes. Students didn't seem as prepared this semester as previous semesters, often not completing homework on time.

For the Summer 2018 semester, there is a new edition of the textbook. I have revised the course to cover one chapter per class, not splitting the chapters as in previous semesters. My hope is that this will provide more consistency for the students and help them better focus on one body system at a time. The tests are also only covering 2 chapters at a time, rather than several chapters.

The instructor was provided with the in-class worksheets used in the day lecture class to compliment the work. The course is being revised with the new edition during the summer semester.

78% (14/18) completed the course with a grade of 75% or greater 22% (4/18) completed the course below 75%. 0 D's , 4 F's

Follow-up:

Improvement was noted in this online section. The students were better prepared and submitted work on time. Additional worksheets used in the face-to-face classes were emailed to struggling students. Students met with the PC more than previous semesters for additional suggestions.
