**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** This course offers an in-depth introduction to scripting languages including basic data types, control structures, regular expressions, input/output, and textual analysis. Students will learn about problem solving and algorithm development and complete programming projects. Semesters offered: Spring Semester

#### STUDENT LEARNING OUTCOMES:

- Communicate effectively with both verbal and written forms
- Apply critical thinking and problem solving skills to algorithm development
- Design and implement simple programs based on user requirements

#### TOTAL HOURS OF COURSEWORK:

To earn one academic credit at HCC, students are required to complete a minimum of 37.5 clock hours (45 fifty-minute "academic" hours) of coursework per semester. Those hours of coursework may be completed through a combination of hours within the classroom and hours outside the classroom. Certain courses may require more than the 37.5 minimum hours of coursework per credit. For this particular class, a 15-week 3 credit class the average student would expect to work 9 fifty-minute "academic" hours per week. Some students may need more and some students may need less.
