COURSE: EMS 284 – Bridge Practicum II

3 Credits

INSTRUCTOR:

SEMESTER/YEAR: Spring 2018

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This course provides supervised clinical experience in various settings for the skills learned during the EMT-I to EMT-P Bridge course. Course fee required. Total of 135 hours of clinical and in class seminars.

Textbook: None

STUDENT LEARNING OUTCOMES:

- Assess patients of different ethnicities while considering cultural beliefs.
- Perform a cumulative amount of 20 pediatric assessments, 40 adult assessments, 10 trauma assessments, 6 AMS patients, 1 cardiac arrest patient, and 40 Team Leads.
- Demonstrate positive patient and team interaction.
- Document patient interaction, including patient complaint, signs/symptoms, physical exam, history, diagnostic treatment, and treatment.
- Work as part of a team in evaluating and treating patients in the hospital and prehospital environments.
- Perform all paramedic skills as a team and ALS Leader in the clinical setting and during field internship

COURSE WORKLOAD: Each 3 credit course requires a total of 112.5 hours of instructional time/student work. The course will have 37.5 hours of instructional time and 75 hours will account for student work outside of instructional time. The average is 5 hours per week of student work.
