Expected Learning Outcomes: Nursing Program Outcomes:

1. Program completion varies by pathway:

- Sixty percent or greater of traditional and two-year program students will complete the nursing program in no more than 150% of the stated program length beginning with enrollment in the first nursing course.
- Sixty percent or greater of Practical Nursing program students will complete the nursing program in no more than 100% of the stated program length beginning with enrollment in the first nursing course.
- Seventy percent or greater of the LPN-RN transition students who begin the program will successfully complete the program within 100% of the time from the date of entry.
- Eighty percent of the Paramedic to RN transition students who begin the program will complete the program will successfully complete the program within 100% of the time from the date of entry.
- 2. Seventy-five percent of the graduate survey respondents at nine months after graduation express satisfaction with the nursing program.
- 3. Ninety percent or greater of the graduate survey respondents will be employed as entry-level practitioners within nine months of graduation.
- 4. Seventy-five percent of the graduate survey respondents will express satisfaction with the curriculum, environment, learning resources, support services, and policies.
- 5. Eighty-five percent or greater of the program graduates will pass the NCLEX on their first attempt.

• Final Exams, ATI exam, Comprehensive Predictor Exam, Clinical Evaluations, Lab Evaluations, 6-month and 12-month student program evaluations, completion results.

Results (What do your assessment data show? If you have not yet assessed student achievement of your learning outcomes, when is assessment planned?)

- 100% of students met all student learning outcomes per 6-month and 12-month graduate surveys.
- There were 28 students in May 2018 there were 3 failures.
- There were 43 students in the December 2018 class---one failure on the NCLEX!
- There were 37 students graduated in May 2018---awaiting them to take the NCLEX.
- MBON counts students from July 1-2017 to June 30, 2018. We have a 98.00 NCLEX average for this time period.. Since July 1, 2018 to present, we have a 98.00% pass rate. This will change as some of the May 2019 graduates will take the NCLEX before June 30.

Follow-up (How have you used or how will you use the data to improve student learning?)

- Continue using Student Support Specialist
- To continue with the remediation specialist to support our nursing students in the LSC.
- Continue using the ATI Nursing Remediation Coordinator
- Review NCLEX program Reports—Compares our NCLEX scores with nursing programs in our jurisdiction, and nationally.
- Review Comp Predictor Results
- Continued use of ATI throughout the RN program
 - 1. ATI Remediation Specialist—Remediation with every student who takes the Comprehensive predictor and does not achieve at least a score of 90% probability of passing the NCLEX Exam.
 - 2. After classes are completed, students attend a 4-day NCLEX live review, remediate and re-take the comp predictor. At this point, most achieve at least 90% on the Comp Predictor.
- Continue to send out 9-month graduate surveys
- Continue to monitor completion data

Continue with ATI, ATI remediation specialist, student support specialist, learning support specialist, nursing faculty and support staff.
