Results:

Course completion:

100% (22/22 students) completed the course with a grade of 75% or higher

0% (0/22 students) completed the course with a grade <75%

Students who are not achieving a 75% or higher at add/drop are encouraged to drop

Course outcome 1: 75% of students get > 75%

Site evaluation= students received 75% or better on their evaluations

Timesheets= students completed 120 hr. of externship

Journals= students completed all journals for DEN140 95%

Course outcome 2: 75% of students get > 75%

Site evaluation= students received 75% or better on their evaluations by the sites

Onsite observation= students received 75% or better on their onsite evaluation

Course outcome 3: 75% of students get >75%

Site evaluations=students received 75% or better on their evaluations by the sites

Onsite observation= 75% of students received 100% on asepsis techniques by their instructor

Course outcome 4: 75% of students get > 75%

Site evaluations=22/22 students 100% achieved national licensure by DANB

Course outcome 5: 75% of students get > 75%

Timesheets= 22/22students achieved 120 hours required

Site evaluation=21/22 students achieved 75% or greater on the site evaluations

Journals=22/22 completed their journals with a 75% or greater

Course outcome 6: 75% of students get > 75%

Journals=22/22 students completed their journals with a 75% or better.

Site evaluation=22/22 students achieved 75% or greater on their site evaluations

Course outcome 7: 75% of students get > 75%

Site evaluation=22/22achieved a 75% or greater on pt. operatory setup

Onsite observation=22/22 students received 75% or greater on site observation

Overall class average for DEN140= 92.5%

Overall class average for site evaluation #1=91.5

Overall class average for site evaluation #2=89.5

Overall class average for Instructor observation= 95.5

Overall class average for 7 journals=78.81
