Course Description

This course is intended to introduce the student to Microsoft-based PCs. Students will learn how to control and manage files using Windows file management. Topics will include: turning on the computer; mouse movement; inserting CD, floppy disks, and micro drives; the Windows environment; naming, renaming, saving, organizing managing files and folders; and email using HCC's student email account. Limited word processing will be covered. Students may test out of this course by taking the SALI computer placement exam. Course fee required. Total of 15 hours of lecture.
