



General Education Outcomes were incorporated into the course curriculum and assessments.

Professors Robert Myers, Joan Johnson, Daniel Ryan, Stephanie Curran, Joseph Marshner, Lore Kuehnert and Suzannah Moran have collaborated in the development of the new General Education Outcomes and assessment criteria. The new outcomes state that students will be able to 1. Analyze how varying conditions of the physical and/or cultural environment contribute to human diversity. 2. Reflect on their developing self-awareness of diverse populations and viewpoints as well as how it impacts the way they interact with a changing world. Cultural Anthropology students are assessed on these outcomes using written essay responses.

Plan of Action: (closing the loop)

Curriculum review and revision has largely been completed to align the course content and assessments with these new outcomes. Minor revisions to assessments and rubrics will be made to further improve student mastery of the course outcomes.
