Discussion of Analysis Results: (narrative in Word format of who, what, where, when, what was discussed and what was determined)

88% of students demonstrated mastery of Outcome 1 and Outcome 2. Over the course of the semester students were repeatedly exposed to issues that emphasized the relationship between various physical and cultural environments, and the resulting human diversity. Through readings, lectures, discussions and assignments, students gained a greater appreciation for divergent viewpoints. Many students expressed that they had a better grasp of human diversity at the end of the course than they did at the beginning, and this was evident in their writing.

Plan of Action: (closing the loop)

The instructor is encouraged by the results of the assignments that were piloted in the fall.

Similar assignments will be given in the spring with some modifications and revisions. An effort will be made to increase active learning opportunities in the classroom to further engage students in the learning process.
