Basic Rider- MST 614

\$269

Fun on two wheels! If you have limited or no motorcycle riding experience, our rider coaches help you develop the skills to operate a motorcycle safely. Six hours of informative classroom and eleven hours of hands-on motorcycle instruction are included. Motorcycles are provided and riding is conducted on a closed range. Successfully complete and receive a certificate for the Maryland Class M license. Maximum of 10 students per class.



Basic Rider for Women Only - MST 448

\$289

No motorcycle experience is required and no gender stress will be allowed. Led by a female instructor, the course provides the same skills as our mixed gender Basic Rider Course for new riders who want to develop the mental and motor skills for safe street operation. Please see Basic Rider Course description for full details. Maximum of 8 students per class.

Alternate Basic Rider - MST 615

\$269

For individuals who have at least six month of current riding experience. This course will make you a safer biker and hone your street skills. Motorcycles are provided for five hours of range instruction. Successfully complete and receive a certificate for the Maryland Class M license. Maximum of 10 students per class.

Basic Rider 2 - MST 616

\$125

For the rider with a class M license, this course provides five hours of instruction covering advanced cornering, braking, and collision avoidance with emphasis on in-traffic strategy and safety. Riders provide their own licensed/tagged motorcycle and proof of insurance. Maximum of 10 students per class.

Group Riding - MST 001

Group motorcycle riding can be fun and safe - if everyone knows the basics for sharing the road with multiple riders. You can master the dynamics of the group ride in this three-hour course: prepare for the ride with advanced planning, adjust ride patterns for new and experienced drivers, and communicate effectively with the rest of the group to minimize accidents.
