Regents Scholars are selected on the basis of demonstrated academic ability. Strong motivation, exceptional character and a record of extracurricular accomplishments are also factors in the selection process. Preference will be given to Maryland residents. The Gross Regents Scholarships for Transfer Students are generally awarded to Maryland community college transfer students who have received the **Associate's degree with a 4.0 Grade Point Average**.
