Strong motivation, exceptional character and a record of extracurricular accomplishments are also factors in the selection process. Preference will be given to Maryland residents. The Kelly Regents Scholarships for Transfer Students may be awarded to Maryland community college transfer students who have completed a **minimum of 56 credits with a 3.8 or higher Grade Point Average and have demonstrated financial need.**
