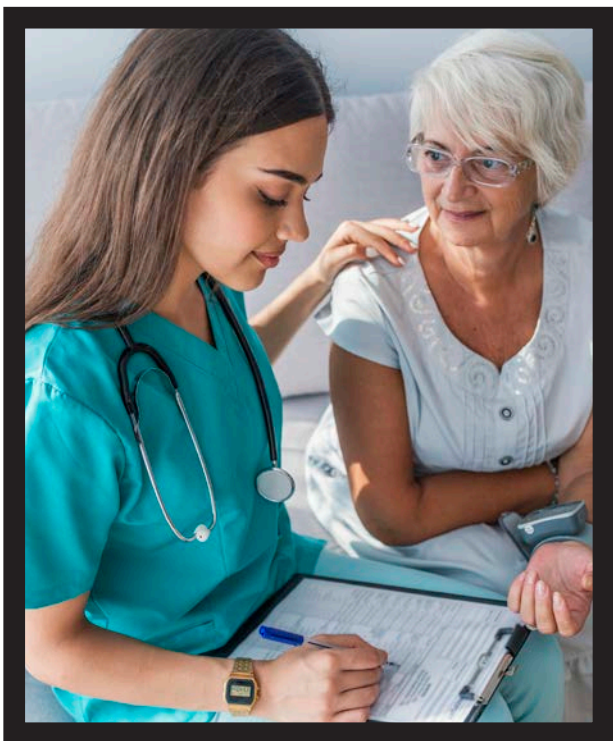




Home Health Provider



The Home Health Provider program is a 2-week course led by a Registered Nurse involving classroom and lab for skill practice. Topics include home care procedures, infection control, body mechanics, communication, safety, nutrition and caring for older adults. CPR and First Aid certification from the American Heart Association is included in the program. A Workforce Development “Certificate of Completion” is awarded upon successful completion.

Scholarships may be available.

What Home Health Aides and Personal Care Aides Do

Home Health Aides and personal care aides help people with disabilities, chronic illnesses, or cognitive impairment by assisting in their daily living activities.

Work Environment

Home health aides and personal care aides work in a variety of settings, including clients' homes, group homes, and day services programs.

What Classes are available?

Theory (HCE-066)

Home Care Providers assist patients in their homes by focusing on their specific health and personal needs. They provide assistance with daily living and self care to those who are disabled, chronically ill, or cognitively impaired. They often help older adults who need assistance. Students will receive training by a Registered Nurse.

Lab Skills (HCE-067)

This is a hands on training course that will give you basic skills you need to take care of the client.
