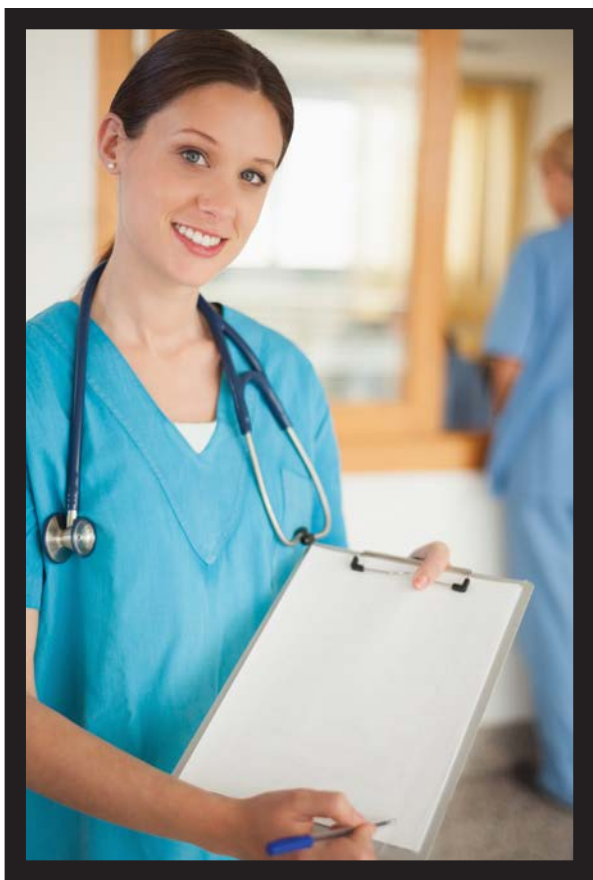




Nurse Refresher Program



The Nurse Refresher Program is a three-step series designed for Registered or Licensed Practical Nurses to reinstate an inactive Maryland nursing license. The Nurse Refresher Program takes approximately 16 weeks to complete.

What credentials can I earn through HCC's program?

Successful completion of HCC's Nurse Refresher course allows nurses with a previous inactive or temporary license to obtain an active nursing licensure as either an RN or an LPN.

What classes are available?

The Nurse Refresher course takes 16 weeks to complete.

Step 1: Nurse Refresher I Classroom Theory

- Consists of 80 hours of theory presented in classroom, online learning, and assignments with the following areas of concentration:
 - Delivery of nursing care utilizing the nursing process
 - Adult Medical/Surgical Nursing
 - Current issues, trends, and nursing practice
- Successful completion includes weekly quizzes greater than 80 percent, participation in online discussion weekly, and 80 percent or higher on the average of four exams spaced throughout the course

Step 2: Nurse Refresher Skills Lab

- Students will be provided all supplies required to review, practice, and demonstrate mastery of 12 nursing skills needed to provide nursing care in a state of the art simulation lab
- Bring your own stethoscope

Step 3: Nurse Refresher Skills Lab

- Step 1 and Step 2 are prerequisites
- Students must complete 60 clinical hours at an approved site
- All requirements listed must be met before starting clinicals
