Graduate Satisfaction and Employment in Nursing

Starting summer 2019, Hagerstown Community College RN graduate surveys were sent at 9 months post-graduation. Surveys are sent to graduates through Survey Monkey and graduates are encouraged to provide anonymous feedback regarding the nursing program. Results are calculated from those graduates who choose to participate.

Graduate satisfaction is calculated by the "strongly agree" or "agree" response to the following question on the graduate survey: Please rate your overall satisfaction with your HCC program: "Overall, I feel that the HCC nursing program adequately prepared me for nursing practice."

Some graduates do not seek employment immediately upon graduation due to changing circumstances, relocation, and/or entering Bachelors of Science in Nursing (BSN) or Masters of Science in Nursing (MSN) program, upon completion of their Associate degree.
