Students who complete a program of study through the Pittsburgh Institute of Aeronautics (PIA) and have received the corresponding industry-recognized technical license or certification may be awarded up to **18 credits** at Hagerstown Community College (HCC) to be granted toward the Associate of Applied Science in Technical Studies.


A.A.S. Technical Studies

The A.A.S. in Technical Studies is a career-oriented program that focuses on applied technical skills. It is designed to support the diverse needs of today's employers and prepares students for in-demand careers in areas like aircraft maintenance, aviation electronics, electrical engineering, electrical energy, alternative energy, advanced manufacturing, and some healthcare fields.

This A.A.S. program is a career degree, preparing students for the workforce after graduation. However, students can opt to transfer to a four-year program rather than start a career, but should confer with advisors and transferring institutions for specific requirements.

Admission Requirements:

- \checkmark Meet with the Director of Admissions at HCC
- Complete the application for admission and choose General Studies as your major
- ✓ Submit official PIA transcripts and take HCC placement tests
- ✓ Attain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0
- ✓ Earn a minimum of 25% of the required program credits at HCC
