- 1. Approval of September Minutes the September meeting minutes were approved by a unanimous vote.
- 2. Covid Survey Results: The results of the Covid survey (attached). Hagerstown Community College developed a survey to assess faculty and staff perceptions of the institution's response to the COVID-19 pandemic. This survey was designed to complement the student survey and gather useful feedback from the faculty and staff of the college. The results of the survey are attached.
- 3. - 5. Plan for timing of Campus climate survey: The PIE Office had decided to delay the campus climate survey in the fall, but may implement it during the Spring Semester.
