

- Submit official scores for all tests previously taken (SAT, ACT, PARCC, AP, TOEFL, CLEP, DSST, IB, Excelsior). You do not need to submit SAT or ACT scores if those tests were taken more than five years ago.
- Take College Placement Exams if required (no fee). Please allow approximately three hours to complete the testing.

#### \* Special Note for Dental Hygiene, Nursing, Practical Nursing, and Radiography Students:

Admission to the college does not guarantee admission to the dental hygiene, nursing, practical nursing, or radiography programs. Enrollment in these programs is selective and limited by the availability of staff and facilities.
