- a) Update on SLOA process
  - Met/not met check boxes for success have now been added to the COG and POG fillable forms as suggested at the previous ASOAC meeting. Dr. Renninger also noted various training videos have been uploaded under SLOA tools on the outcomes assessment webpage.

## 3. New Business

- a) Selection of Academic Programs
  - The group discussed the idea of limiting the number of academic programs that a student can be active in at one time. M. Stonestreet noted that she feels advising students in multiple programs is confusing for both faculty advisors and students. C.
