- Request that official transcripts from all higher education institutions attended be sent directly to HCC.
- A transfer credit evaluation will not be completed until all official transcripts have been received and a Transcript
   Evaluation Request form has been submitted. The form can be found at www.hagerstowncc.edu/admissions/transfer students
- Submit official scores for all tests previously taken (SAT, ACT, MCAP, AP, TOEFL, CLEP, DSST, IB, Excelsior). You do not need to submit SAT or ACT scores if those tests were taken more than five years ago.
- Take College Placement Exams if required (no fee). Please allow approximately three hours to complete the testing.

### \* Special Note for Dental Hygiene, Nursing, Practical Nursing, and Radiography Students:

Admission to the college does not guarantee admission to the dental hygiene, nursing, practical nursing, or radiography programs. Enrollment in these programs is selective and limited by the availability of staff and facilities.

Students should contact the Office of Admissions or an academic advisor for more information on the selection process. For consideration, a "Supplemental Application for Selective Admissions Programs" and all required documentation must be submitted according to the deadline below.
