


THE CAMPUS


Hagerstown Community College was founded in 1946 as the first of its kind in Maryland. The 319-acre campus has 18 buildings, including:

Enrollment and Outcomes


Special Programs

- Early College HCC enrolled I,088 high school students in FY2I, which accounts for 21.8% of credit enrollment
 - The Middle College program graduated 130 and enrolled 65 students in Fall 2021
 - In FY21, ESSENCE enrolled over 1,000 high school students
- Learning Support Center an awardwinning program that provides dedicated space and staff to offer tutoring in all subject areas (data shows rising student success rates as a result)


PROGRAMS OF STUDY
