

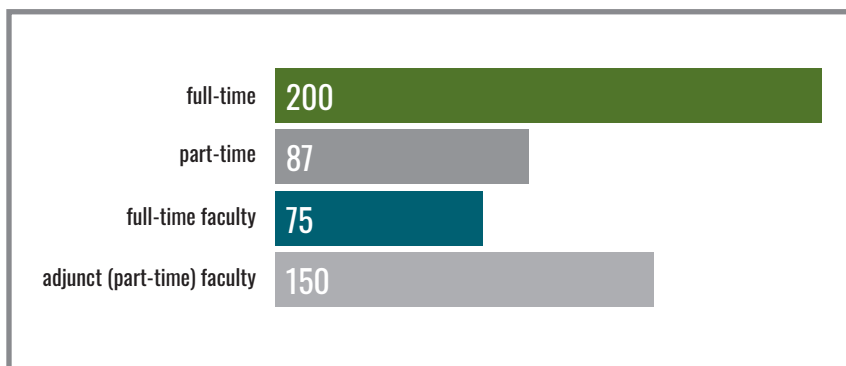


THE CAMPUS

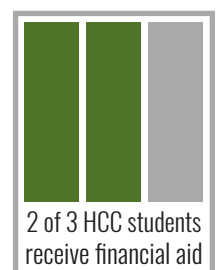
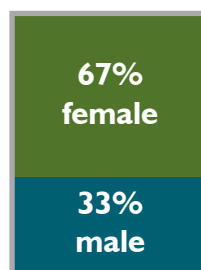
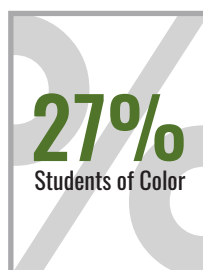
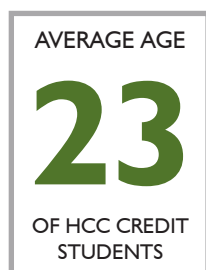
Enrollment and Outcomes

- 4,996 credit students (FY21)
- 4,508 non-credit students (FY21)
- HCC's average graduation rate of 33% is one of the highest among all community colleges in Maryland

Special Programs

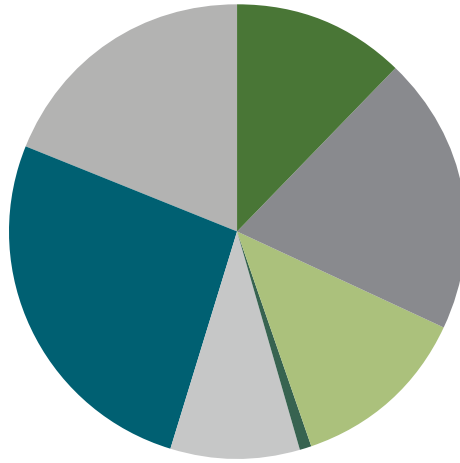
- Early College – HCC enrolled 1,088 high school students in FY21, which accounts for 21.8% of credit enrollment
 - ▶ The Middle College program graduated 130 and enrolled 65 students in Fall 2021
 - ▶ In FY21, ESSENCE enrolled over 1,000 high school students
- Learning Support Center – an award-winning program that provides dedicated space and staff to offer tutoring in all subject areas (data shows rising student success rates as a result)

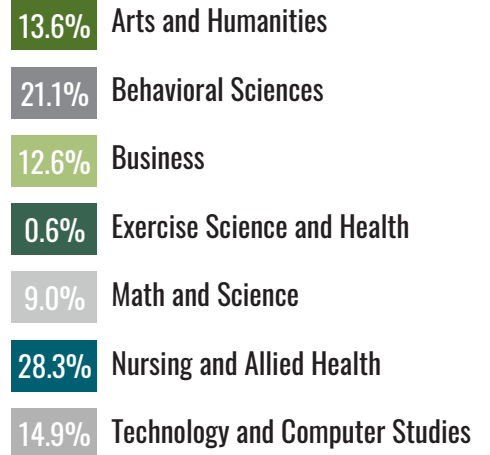


PROGRAMS OF STUDY

- The Registered Nursing Program at Hagerstown Community College has been ranked number two in the state of Maryland for 2022, by RegisteredNursing.org.

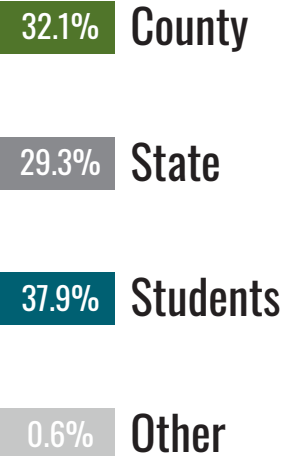
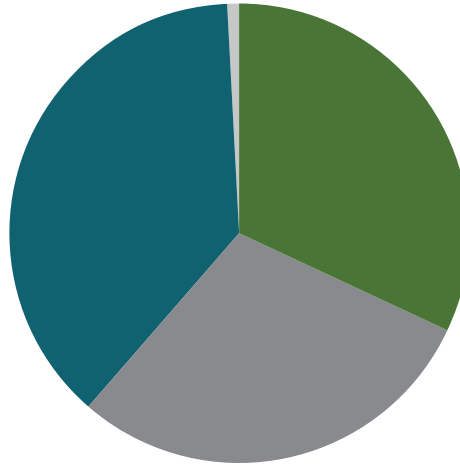


Graduates by area of study AY21 (826 total)
