



Articulation Agreement

Hagerstown Community College and Collegium Sanctorum Angelorum

Purpose

The purpose of this agreement is to set guidelines for establishing a cooperative relationship between the Collegium Sanctorum Angelorum (hereafter the Collegium) and Hagerstown Community College (hereafter HCC) and to facilitate mobility of students who wish to transfer from HCC to the Collegium without duplication of courses.

Agreement

Whereas the Collegium and HCC are committed to expanding educational opportunities for students, and

Whereas the two institutions are committed to providing a smooth transition for students wishing to transfer credits from HCC to the Collegium in order to earn a bachelor's degree in liberal arts at the Collegium, and

Whereas the intent of the two institutions is to avoid duplication of curricula where appropriate within articulated courses, and

Whereas the two institutions can better serve the educational growth of students and the development of their respective communities through cooperative educational planning and optimal utilization of resources,

Be it Resolved that this agreement commits the partners to fully support an articulation of the following courses and credits offered by the two institutions:



Mutual Terms and Conditions:

1. Both educational institutions will cooperate in disseminating articulated course information to students.
2. Students transferring from HCC to the Collegium may transfer credits, ordinarily up to a maximum of 65 credit hours; but on a case-by-case basis the Collegium may accept a greater number of credit hours, not to exceed 90 credit hours, toward their baccalaureate degree.
3. Students are subject to the policies and procedures of both institutions.
4. Students intending to transfer from HCC to the Collegium should complete the admissions process for the Collegium during the Fall semester of the year prior to transferal.
5. A Curriculum Equivalency Guide will be created by the Dean of Academics of the Collegium to identify courses that will effectively transfer from HCC to the Collegium.
6. Both parties will comply with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) and all associated regulations, taking the necessary steps to ensure that confidential personal information is not disclosed or distributed.
7. A review of the agreement shall be conducted by both institutions every five years from the date of execution.
8. Both institutions may at any time initiate changes to this articulation agreement. Both institutions reserve the right to modify courses as deemed necessary and agree to inform the appropriate individuals of said changes.


The signatures below will finalize this Articulation Agreement between the Collegium and Hagerstown Community College and form the basis of a lasting relationship that will benefit each institution and its students.


