## HCC's Early College Degree Program Admission Criteria Fall 2023

Students must meet the following criteria to be eligible to enroll in the Fall 2023 semester at Hagerstown Community College:

## You must:

- Be a rising 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade student during the 2023-2024 school year.
- Be 17 years of age or younger on September 1, 2023.
- Have a high school cumulative GPA of 3.75 or higher.
- Have an interest in and an aptitude for STEM, business, or the arts.
- Complete the entire Early College Degree Program application process.

## Follow the steps listed below in order to apply for the Early College Degree Program!

STEP 1	<ul> <li>Attend an Early College Degree Program (ECDP) Information Session</li> <li>Details about upcoming sessions are listed on the ECDP website (<u>https://www.hagerstowncc.edu/earlycollegedegree</u>)</li> </ul>
STEP 2	<ul> <li>Apply to HCC using the online application</li> <li>The application can be found at <u>www.hagerstowncc.edu/admissions</u></li> <li>This application generates an acceptance letter from the college and your Student ID number.</li> <li>** This letter does not mean that you have been accepted to the ECDP. The ECDP sends out separate letters if you are accepted to the program.</li> </ul>
STEP 3	<ul> <li>Complete the Early College Degree Program application packet</li> <li>The application packet can be found on the ECDP website (you will need to print it out), your high school counselor's office, or the HCC Admissions Office.</li> <li>Use the checklist on Page 2 of the packet to ensure that you complete and attach all of the required forms.</li> <li>**This includes the separate HCC Early College Form. This form must be signed by the student, parent/guardian, counselor, AND principal for the application to be considered complete.</li> </ul>
STEP 4	<ul> <li>Steps 1-3 must be fully completed and submitted by the following dates:</li> <li>March 1, 2023 for priority consideration</li> <li>May 1, 2023 for regular decision (a limited number of applications may be considered after this date)</li> </ul>

Additional Information: Once applications are received, they will be reviewed and scored to

determine admission into the Early College Degree Program fall cohort. Students will be notified of their application status by a letter through the mail. The letter will state that the student's application for admission to the Early College Degree Program has either been accepted or denied.

More information regarding each status can be found here:

- "Accepted" Students that have been accepted will be asked to accept their seat by a certain date, submit a \$50.00 deposit to hold their seat (If the student receives Free or Reduced Meals (FARM) at WCPS—this fee does not apply), and make an appointment to schedule their fall classes.
- 2. "Denied"—Students may be denied based on GPA, college-readiness, or not meeting the minimal requirements for admission.
