Admission Requirements – Due by Application Deadline

Apply by January 15 for Summer Entry

- Submit passing scores for the official [TEAS](#) (Test of Essential Academic Skills) test score report.
 - Test is valid for three years from the testing date.
 - Minimum scores for application are a **60% overall** and **69% in reading**.
- GenEd science courses cannot be older than 7 years at application deadline.
- Completed Gen Ed courses must have a grade of “C” or higher at application deadline. If the grade is below a “C”, that grade must be replaced before the student is eligible to apply.
- Minimum 2.0 Cumulative GPA (all college coursework).
- Minimum 2.5 Program GPA (Gen Ed course requirements).
- Official Transcripts – must submit transcripts from **ALL** schools attended, even if the courses won’t transfer.
 - Foreign transcripts must be evaluated by [World Education Services](#) (WES).
- Supplemental Application for the [Military Medic - RN](#).
- DD214 or have documented past/present status of a “Navy Corpsman” (HM3) course completed, NER-HM-004, “Army 91 WM6”, or “USAF4NO” skill identifier.
- SMART transcripts showing experiences with use of administration of medication, documentation of patient care, experiences with use of medical and surgical asepsis, and maintaining safety in patient care.
- Satisfactory letter of recommendation from most recent employer.
- Employer verification of at least 2 years employment as a Military Medic/Corpsman within the past 5 years.
