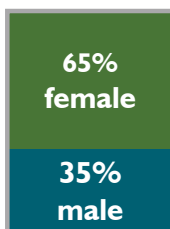
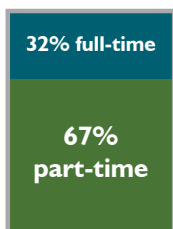
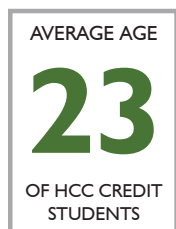
## THE CAMPUS

Hagerstown Community College was founded in 1946 as the first of its kind in Maryland. The main campus sits on 319 acres and includes 18 buildings. HCC also operates a satellite center at the Valley Mall and a truck driving range in Hagerstown. More than 100 programs of study are available for university transfer, career preparation, and personal enrichment. HCC also offers non-credit Workforce Solutions and Continuing Education courses and customized training programs, as well as remedial and developmental courses to help students prepare for college-level offerings. Accredited by the Middle States Commission on Higher Education HCC awards associate degrees, certificates, and letters of recognition.

## THE EMPLOYEES

HCC employs approximately 700 individuals each year in full and part-time positions. Hundreds of student workers and campus volunteers also serve the campus community. - \$123 per credit hour plus fees for in-county residents
- \$192 per credit hour plus fees for out-of-county residents
- \$252 per credit hour plus fees for out-of-state residents
- \$236 per credit hour plus fees for those who qualify for the Neighbor-State Rate (Franklin and Fulton Counties, Pa.; Berkeley, Morgan, and Jefferson Counties, W.Va.; and Loudoun County, Va.)

## FINANCIAL AID

Two of three HCC students receive financial aid. The HCC Foundation awards more than \$500,000 annually in student scholarships.
