Admission Requirements – Due April 1st

Apply by April 1 for Fall Entry

- Students must complete 8 hours of observation with a Dental Hygienist and submit a signed <u>Dental Hygienist Observation</u> <u>Form</u>. Observation must be completed within 3 years of application deadline.
- Submit passing scores for the <u>ACT[®] WorkKeys</u> test.
 - Minimum passing scores required are 5 in Applied Math, 5 in Graphic Literacy, and 4 in Workplace Documents.
 - Test is valid for three years from the testing date.
- ENG101, CHM101, BIO116, and the Math Gen Ed must be completed or in progress at application deadline.
- BIO116, BIO205, and CHM101 cannot be older than 5 years at application deadline.
- Completed Gen Ed courses must have a grade of "C" or higher at application deadline. If the grade is below a "C", that grade must be replaced before the student is eligible to apply.
- Minimum 2.0 Cumulative GPA (all college coursework).
- Minimum 2.5 Program GPA (Gen Ed course requirements).
- Official Transcripts must submit transcripts from ALL schools attended, even if the courses won't transfer.
 Foreign transcripts must be evaluated by World Education Services (WES).
- Supplemental Application for <u>Dental Hygiene</u>.
